

Dr. Orhan Derman

Biography

Dr. Derman graduated from Fevziye Mektepleri Işık Private High School and Istanbul University Cerrahpaşa Faculty of Medicine. He completed his specialty education at the Department of Child Health and Diseases of Dicle University Faculty of Medicine in 1998. He became assistant professor in 2000, associate professor in 2004 and professor in 2010.

He studied at Adolescence Unit of Ohio Columbus Children's Hospital with Stecker Scholarship for three months in 2002. He worked as a fellow at Adolescence Unit of Children's Hospital of Pittsburgh between the years of 2003 and 2004. In this period, he was nominated by Adolescence Unit to work at medico-social, house of correction and help centers of substance users and victims of sexual abuse. He studied at Developmental Health Clinic of Harvard Children's Hospital, the U.S.A, with Fogarty scholarship for four months in 2010 and he took courses of Ethics and Health Disparities, Community Intervention Research Methods, Reproductivity and Gender, and Women Sexuality at Harvard School of Public Health.

He has been serving as the Head of Adolescent Health Association since 2008, board member of Prevention of Child Abuse and Neglect Association since 2006 and the Head of Adolescence Unit since 2007.

He carried out studies on the issues of adolescent gynecology, malnutrition, breast problems, sports medicine, prevention of child abuse and neglect, and substance addiction.

He took his master degree at Department of Sociology of Hacettepe University Faculty of Letters.

His professional interests include adolescence and its problems.
